ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR B.ED PROGRAMME:

The admission to B.Ed program will be made on the basis of merit of percentage of the qualifying examination through online counselling by CRSU, Jind.

Eligibility

Candidates with at least 50% marks either in the bachelor's degree and/or in the Master's degree in sciences/social science/humanity, Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are eligible for admission to the programme.

DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS

Distribution of seats

The seats shall be distributed as under:

1) All India Category including Haryana: 15%

2) Bonafide Residents of Haryana: 85%

DIVISION OF SEATS IN B.ED. PROGRAMME

50% of the total seats in each college shall be reserved for Group-I i.e. Science & Arts with Mathsgroupcandidates. Other 50% seats shall be reserved for Group-II i.e. Arts & Commerce Group Candidates.

Note:

The seats which remain vacant in Group-I i.e. Science& Arts with Maths-group can be converted in Group-II i.e. Arts & Commerce Group and vice-versa. Such vacant seats of one group will be converted into same category (General or Reserved) of the other group and if still these seats remain vacant only then these will be converted into General Category.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR D.EL.ED PROGRAMME:

The Merit List will be prepared purely on the basis of percentage of marks obtained in 10+2 examination stream-wise (Arts, Science, Commerce & Vocational).

Eligibility

(I) Diploma in Elementary Education (D.El.Ed.)

i. Candidates with at least 50% marks in Senior Secondary (10+2) from Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani or its equivalent examination with

- five subjects including pass English as one of the subject.
- ii. There shall be a relaxation of 5% marks in minimum qualifying marks i.e 47.5% at Senior Secondary (10+2) level for Scheduled Castes (SC), Backward Classes (BC) and Differently abled candidates.
- iii. Matric with Hindi/ Sanskrit

DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS

The Merit List will be prepared purely on the basis of percentage of marks obtained in 10+2 examination stream-wise (Arts, Science, Commerce & Vocational) and distribution of seats in each stream for each institution shall be as under:-

Stream-wise % of seats allotted

Stream	Seats
Science	30%
Commerce	28%
Arts	40%
Vocational	02%

Note:

- 1. The latest reservation policy of Haryana Govt. shall be applicable to all the admissions. 15% seats are open for All India including Haryana state. Seats remaining vacant in any category shall be converted to Haryana Open category or All India category as per rule.
- 2. If the seats in Science stream remain vacant, these will be converted into Commerce Stream and vice versa.
- 3. The seats remain vacant in Science, Commerce and Vocational Education stream shall be converted in to Arts stream seats.

Stream Subjects: (Required fives Subjects)

- 1. Science Stream English(compulsory) and at least three subjects from:-
 - Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics/Biology/One Science Stream subject defined by Secretary, Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani.
- **2. Commerce** English (compulsory) and at least three subjects from:-Business Studies, Accountancy, Mathematics/Economics/ One Commerce Stream subject defined by Secretary, Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani.
- **3. Arts- English** (compulsory) with any four subjects of arts stream defined by Secretary, Board of School Education Haryana, Bhiwani.

4. Vocational- English (compulsory) and all other basic subjects in Vocational Institutes affiliated by the Board ofSchool Education Haryana, Bhiwanior any Technical Diploma approved by Technical Education Department Haryana/ passed 12th with NSQF from Board of School Education Haryana Bhiwani or its equivalent.

The candidates are advised to apply for stream as per their subject combination in Senior Secondary examination and if any candidate does not apply in proper stream as mentioned above, his/her candidature will be treated as cancelled and no claim will be entertained in this regard.
