



ANTIRAGGING CELL:

The Anti-Ragging Cell, established according to the regulations of the UGC, is the moral police of our college. The Cell's responsibility is to ensure that students maintain discipline in the classrooms and within the college campus. Members of the cell regularly go on rounds to each and every classroom to make note of errant behavior and to make sure that the college campus is free from ragging and eve-teasing. The Cell takes severe punitive action against students indulging in such heinous activities.

Students can make use of the suggestion boxes placed on different just outside office of the college to make their complaints regarding ragging. They may also approach the members of the cell or any of their other teachers as is comfortable to them.

Students may also express their grievances online by filling out the form below.

Students are requested to note that making a complaint is serious and therefore they are to use this power in a responsible manner. At the same time, the college assures students that once a complaint is made, it will be treated with **Sensitivity** and **Confidentiality**.

WHAT CONSTITUTES RAGGING?

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts as listed in the above mentioned UGC regulation:

1. Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other

students.

2. Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student
3. Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student
4. Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
5. Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
6. Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students;
7. Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person;

8. Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student;
9. Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

Action(s) taken by the University in the event of Ragging:

Depending upon the gravity of offence as established by the anti-ragging committee of University. Punishments for those found guilty of ragging shall be any one or any combination of the following:

1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
2. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
3. Forfeiting Campus Placement opportunities / recommendations.
4. Forfeiting Campus Placement opportunities / recommendations.
5. Withholding of results.
6. Debarring from representing the University/Institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.

7. Suspension/expulsion from the.

8. Cancellation of admission.

9. Rustication from the University for a period ranging from one to two years.

10. Expulsion from the University and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.

11. A fine of INR 50,000/-

SAY NO TO RAGGING

Ragging is neither a means of familiarization, nor an introduction with fresher's, but a form of Psychopathic behaviour. Ragging is a violation of Human Rights. Respect for Humanitarian Values. Ragging is a heinous crime, heavily punishable under the law. Ragging may spoil your career forever.

FOLLOWING BEHAVIOUR WITH FRESHERS IN THE COLLEGE IS TANTAMOUNT TO RAGGING:

- Force students to address seniors as 'Sir '
- Force students to perform mass drills.
- Force students to copy class notes for the seniors.
- Force students to run various errands.
- Force students to do menial jobs for the seniors.
- Force students to ask/answer vulgar questions.
- Force students to watch pornographic pictures

- Force students to drink alcohol, scalding tea, smoking, etc.
- Force students to perform acts which can lead to physical injury/ mental torture or death
- Force students to perform acts with sexual overtones, including homosexual acts.

PUNITIVE MEASURES FOR RAGGING CAN BE TAKEN BY COLLEGE:

Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the College, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging shall be one or any combination of the following:

- Cancellation of admission.
- Suspension from attending classes.
- Debarring from any test/examination or any other evaluation process
- Collective punishment when individuals committing or abetting ragging are not identified.
- Rigorous imprisonment and fine up to Rs. 25000/.
